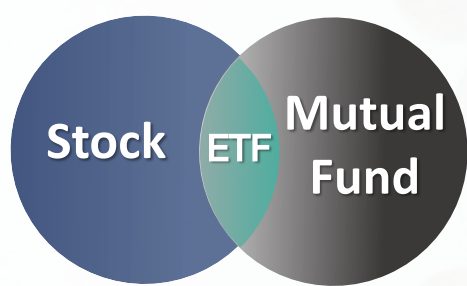


Diversify your foreign investments with ETFs

What is ETF?

ETF or Exchange Traded Fund is an Index Fund that has an investment policy based on various indexes. The ETF wants to generate returns that are as close to movement of index as possible.



$$\text{ETF} = \text{Stock} + \text{Mutual Fund}$$

Why are ETFs interesting?

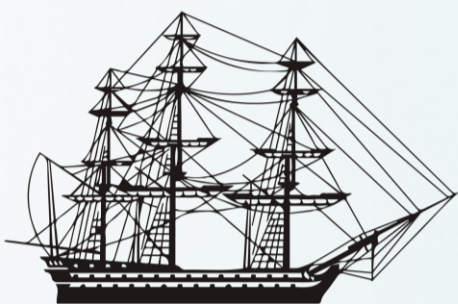
- ✓ Can be traded on the board like “Stock”.
- ✓ Option to diversify your investments in many stocks like a “Mutual Fund”.
- ✓ Low cost for “Expense Ratio”.
- ✓ You can start investing with even a small amount of money.
- ✓ Know the price immediately, no need to wait for NAV at the end of the day.

ประเภทของ ETF

- ✓ Generate returns on many types of assets such as money markets, debt instruments, stocks, commodities, alternative assets and currencies, etc.
- ✓ Example of an ETF that generates returns based on US indexes such as SPDR S&P 500 ETF Trust (SPY US), Vanguard S&P 500 ETF (VOO US), Invesco QQQ trust, Series 1 (QQQ US)
